

U. P. Writer Praises Las Vegas Today

George D. Crissey, manager of the intermountain bureau of the United Press, at Salt Lake City, and wife and Miss Eleanor Blake, cousin of Mrs. Crissey, were at the Apache Saturday and Sunday nights. They spent their time Sunday and today in visiting different points of interest in Las Vegas, Boulder City and the dam. This was Crissey's first visit here since 1924.

Asked if he noticed many changes in Las Vegas, he declared that he had never observed such a transformation in a place. "Why, when I was here nine years ago," he said, "this was only a struggling village. Look at it now! It's assuming the proportions of a city, and still growing!"
