

3 Projects Favored By Works Board

WASHINGTON, Aug. 1. (AP)—

The public works administration allotted nearly \$100,000,000 to carry forward the work on three projects, it was revealed today, the Grand Coulee dam, on the Columbia river, the Casper-Alcova reclamation project and the upper Mississippi channel projects being favored.

Secretary Ickes said that the board did not consider the proposed all-American canal project today, but said that he expected it would come before the board "within a reasonable time."

The board refused requests for funds from the Metropolitan Water district in southern California, saying that the refusal did not mean that it could not secure further funds if they were found to be needed later.
