

Malone Sifting Public Work Plan

George W. Malone, state engineer, spent this morning in Las Vegas conferring with Ed W. Clark, member of the public works advisory board, to outline plans for pushing the Muddy river flood control program which is one of the five reclamation projects included in the set up submitted to reclamation bureau for consideration.

Malone said he had received a request from Dr. Elwood Mead, commissioner of reclamation, for further data on the land to be affected by the improvement, and discussed with Clark the best method for providing this information.

It is expected the organization meeting of the state advisory board will be held in Carson City within the next few days, and that this matter will come up for consideration at that time.

Malone, accompanied by his wife, left this noon for the capital.
