
Lower Santa Cruz River Basin Study: Timeline, Budget and Plan of Study Updates

Time Extension / Budget Increase Request granted

- Reclamation Policy Office approved extension of Study deadline from 2/10/2019 to 9/30/2020 (an additional year and 7 months)
- Reclamation Policy Office approved request for an additional \$325,000 to the original Federal contribution of \$392,750 for a total of \$717,750
- Non-federal in-kind cost-share requirement will increase by \$325,000, from \$393,000 to \$718,000 (an estimated \$350,663 has already been contributed)
 - need current hourly rates with overhead, if not transmitted already
- Total estimated cost of study is now \$1,435,750

How will additional funds be used?

- Additional funds will be used to cover the cost of:
 - Including dynamically downscaled climate projections
 - Developing weather generator
 - Use of Sacramento Soil Moisture Accounting Model (SAC-SMA)
 - Integration of SAC-SMA recharge projections with TAMA Modflow model
 - Development of environmental analysis methods
 - Increased labor costs for Reclamation engineers

• September 2018

Approval of "Best Case" and "Worse Case" climate scenarios (required for surface hydrologic modeling)

Begin development of TAMA groundwater pumping input files from CAP:SAM projections

November 2018

Presentation of surface hydrology results

December 2018

Presentation on surface hydrology impacts on riparian areas

January 2019

Presentation on groundwater modeling results

February 2019

Presentation on groundwater hydrology impacts on riparian areas

Suggested Plan of Study Updates

- Change reporting frequency to semi-annually from quarterly
- Updated Budget
- Updated Timeline

What's next in this process?

- Reclamation will draft a amendment to the original Memorandum of Agreement, changing only term of agreement and amount of cost-share contribution
- Non-Federal Partner signatories will be asked to sign amendment (SAWUA, PAG, CAP, ADWR, UA, CMID)
- Signed copies of amendment will be collected and sent to Reclamation's Lower Colorado Regional Office for signature by the Regional Director
- Signed copies of amendment will be returned to Partners.
- Target date for execution of amendment end of calendar 2018.
