Subject: Notice of Availability of a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) and Final Environmental Assessment (EA) for a Recreational Trail Along the Central Arizona Project (CAP) Canal in the Pinal County, Arizona

The Bureau of Reclamation has determined that the proposed 10.5-mile recreational trail along the CAP canal and the associated trailhead parking lot within Pinal County, is not a major federal action significantly affecting the quality of the human environment. A Notice of Availability for the draft EA was issued on April 25, 2018, with comments due on May 25, 2018. Two comment letters were received: one from Pima County Natural Resources Parks and Recreation Department in support of the project, and one from the Arizona Game and Fish Department with recommendations for the project. Reclamation has determined that the proposed action will not significantly impact the environment, and an Environmental Impact Statement is not required.
