Environmental Assessment (EA) for delivery of Central Arizona Project (CAP) water

leased from the Gila River Indian Community (Community) to an existing

Groundwater Savings Facility (GSF) owned and operated by the Farmers Investment

Co. (FICO) for Freeport-McMoRan Sierrita Inc.

The Bureau of Reclamation has determined that plans to connect a water delivery pipeline to the CAP and deliver CAP water leased from the Community to an existing GSF operated by the FICO is not a major federal action significantly affecting the quality of the human environment.
