Not included in this request are the following: M.C.A.S., Southern Pacific, Desert Lawn, Yuma Mesa Fruit Growers, City of Yuma, County of Yuma, and WAPA.

This requested does not include any reduction for land that may be fallowed as part of a System Conservation Program in 2012. Thank you in advance for your consideration of this request.

There are two issues with the Potential to impact the District's Imperial Dam diversion or consumptive use in year 2011.

- 1) A 400 acre ranch on drip irrigation may build infrastructure to bring it into the service area

- 2) The United States and Mexico are at this time negotiating a "Mexican Intentionally Created Surplus" which could possibly effect pumping in the Yuma area and YMIDD's return flow credits and consumptive use.
