Note 1: January through November 2012 are metered volumes

Note 2: December is the only estimated demand in 2012. December typically has slightly less demand than November but based on the increased number of meter sets, I used the total volume from November 2012 as the estimated December demand

Note 3: MCAS demand is not included in the estimate. Based on conversation with USBR, any water provided to the installation by the City will be counted against MCAS' entitlement.

Note 4: Additional water use in 2013 is estimated at 1 million gallons per day. The estimated increase includes water used for increased flushing to meet regulatory requirements, increased construction activities, and increased customer demand. 1 million gallons per day= 3.068887 acre feet.

Note 5: 1500 acre feet was added to the annual total for water treatment to account for annual water diversions for Smucker Park, Desert Hills Golf Course and Yuma Cogeneration Associates. Annual diversion data for these three users provided by P. Matuska, USBR

**Based on estimated demand, I recommend that the City request 24,735 AF for 2013**
