Subject: Approval of Calendar Year 2013 Diversion for the Cibola Valley Irrigation and  
Drainage District (District)

Dear Mr. Swan:

In accordance with Title 43, Code of Federal Regulations Part 417 (Part 417), this letter provides the District with notice of my determination regarding the District's proposed diversion and beneficial use of Colorado River water for calendar year 2013.

Under Contract No. 2-07-30-W0028, as amended, the District is entitled to divert up to 9,366 acre-feet per year of Arizona fourth priority Colorado River water, of which 300 acre-feet may be used for domestic use. Under this same contract, the District is also entitled to divert up to 1,500 acre-feet per year of Arizona fifth priority and up to 2,000 acre-feet per year of Arizona sixth priority Colorado River water.

Within the District's boundaries, other entities have entitlements to Colorado River water and the District orders water on behalf of these entities. The Mohave County Water Authority (MCWA) has a fourth priority entitlement for 4,278 acre-feet. The Hopi Tribe has a fourth priority entitlement for 4,278 acre-feet, a fifth priority entitlement for 750 acre-feet, and a sixth priority entitlement for 1,000 acre-feet. The Arizona Game and Fish Commission (AGFC) has a fourth priority entitlement for 2,838 acre-feet, a fifth priority entitlement for 750 acre-feet, and a sixth priority entitlement for 1,000 acre-feet. Arizona Recreational Facilities, LLC (ARF) has a fourth priority entitlement for 2,686 acre-feet.

The District's calendar year 2013 diversion request results in the delivery of all Arizona fourth priority, a portion of Arizona fifth priority, and none of Arizona sixth priority water entitlements that are within its boundaries. This is reflected in the following table.

Based upon a review of the calendar year 2013 diversion estimate provided by the District which included diversion estimates for the entitlement holders listed above, and the information gathered during the Bureau of Reclamation's annual Part 417 consultation process, I approve the diversion of up to 25,947 acre-feet of Colorado River water (23,446 acre-feet of Arizona fourth priority and 2,501 acre-feet of Arizona fifth priority) during calendar year 2013 for use within the District's boundaries.

Reclamation will monitor and project diversions and consumptive use of Colorado River water during calendar year 2013 in an effort to ensure each entitlement holder's annual approval is not exceeded. Beginning in February 2013, these projections will be available to water users on a daily basis on Reclamation's website: [www.usbr.gov/lc/region/g4000/hourly/forecast13.pdf](http://www.usbr.gov/lc/region/g4000/hourly/forecast13.pdf). It is expected that Arizona entitlement holders will use this information to adjust diversions to remain within approved annual quantities or, as appropriate, seek modification of the approval.
