Subject: CAP 2014 Diversion Estimate

Listed below are the Central Arizona Project's (CAP's) monthly Colorado River diversion estimates, to be pumped through the Mark Wilmer (Havasu) Pumping Plant, for calendar year 2014:

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CAP has planned its 2014 diversions to divert Arizona's full 2.8 MAF apportionment. Monthly diversion estimates will be adjusted after we receive your forecast showing Arizona's mainstream uses.

CAP requests approval to adjust pumping to the amount shown on the USBR website. As the end of 2014 approaches, if it appears that Arizona will use less than its full apportionment, CAP may increase its diversions in November and December to use the full apportionment. In our efforts to monitor end-of-year uses, CAP staff will be consulting with your office, ADWR and Arizona's mainstream users. In the event that Arizona's final 2014 use is below its 2.8 MAF apportionment, we would expect the unused amount to remain in system storage.

To support the request for the estimated 2014 Colorado River diversion and the Part 417 Consultation process, a copy of the CAP 2012 Annual Report will be forwarded to you. The report provides current information that is pertinent to CAP's operating practices in the diversion, delivery, distribution and use of Colorado River water.
