Subject: Revised 2014 Water Order for Colorado River Water

The Coachella Valley Water District (CVWD) submits the following revision of its 2014 water order for Colorado River water. The revised order equates to the consumptive use of approximately 344,558 acre-feet of Colorado River water.

The Colorado River water order reflects the subtraction of:

-26,000 acre-feet for Coachella Canal Lining, and
-3,000 acre-feet for Present Perfected Rights, and
-2,293 acre-feet for Coachella Canal Lining Environmental Mitigation – water allocated but not used.

And the addition of:

+14,851 acre-feet from the 1988 IID-MWD Water Conservation Agreement, and
+31,000 acre-feet from IID-CVWD Acquisition Agreement (2003 QSA), and
+0 acre-feet from the Agreement for 35,000 Acre-feet Exchange Water (2003 QSA, MWDC).

This revised water order reflects CVWD's best estimate of its anticipated 2014 consumptive use. Should CVWD's actual 2014 consumptive use differ from the schedule reflected in this revised water order, CVWD requests that Reclamation adjust the amount of Colorado River water available to CVWD under the 1988 IID/MWD Water Conservation Agreement to offset the difference, with the exact amount to be determined at the end of the year.

Enclosed are CVWD's monthly consumptive use estimates for Colorado River water. These estimates include direct and in-lieu groundwater recharge for the benefit of Improvement District No. 1.
