Dear Ms. Gould:

This is to advise you that in an email dated January 2, 2023, the Mexican Section of the International Boundary and Water Commission (MxIBWC), on behalf of the State Public Utility Commission of Tijuana (CESPT), requested an emergency modification to the 2023 Colorado River Monthly Delivery Schedule. This request is being made to perform repairs on the Colorado River-Tijuana Aqueduct due to a leak discovered on December 30, 2022 which necessitated the suspension of water deliveries through that facility.

The January 2nd modification called for additional emergency deliveries to Tijuana, B.C. for the months of January and February 2023 in the total delivery amount of 1,512,000 cubic meters. After application of requisite conveyance loss charges this results in a total diversion at Parker Dam of 1,629,562 cubic meters for both months. I note this volume is in addition to those already schedule for later in the year, beginning in April 2023. The California Agencies confirmed their ability execute the delivery request to Tijuana, B.C. for January and February, by email on January 4, 2023 and deliveries commenced on January 9, 2023. Official correspondence was received on January 12, 2022 confirming the capacity determination made by the California Agencies. It is my understanding that Sean Shrag-Toso, Hydrologist, noted on January 3, 2023 that Reclamation had no administrative or operational concerns with this request at that time. The result of this modification and the monthly distribution of flows is shown in the attached table, labeled "Schedule 2".

The USIBWC appreciates Reclamation's assistance in accommodating this emergency modification request from CESPT. This confirms the data provided to Mr. Jeremy Dodds, Water Accounting and Verification Group Manager, on January 2, 2023. I would appreciate your formal confirmation of Reclamation's ability to execute the requested deliveries in the revised schedule.
