

The Tribe will fallow 48.5 acres of land that would have been planted to small grain pasture in the absence of a payback obligation. The small grain pasture would have required 3.2 acre feet per acre thus conserving the required 155 acre feet.

The Tribe's 2013 water order, to be submitted, will be for 16,565 acre feet against a 16,720 acre foot entitlement reflecting the reduction.

3 Location and Schedule of Fallowing with the Amount of Water Conserved

Location: Easterly 48.5 acres of Field #26, Avi Kwa.Ame Farms. See attached map

Schedule: All of calendar year 2013

Water Conserved: 155 acre feet

4 Monitoring and Verifying Conservation Measures

The Conservation Area will be plainly marked and available for inspection at any time.


The above referenced Inadvertent Overrun and Payback Policy payback for a 2011 overrun of 155 acre feet was followed with the following notes and exceptions.

- The field to be fallowed had growing small grain pasture on January 1, 2013 with sufficient moisture from irrigation and December rains to provide pasturage for about six weeks.
- The area experienced a series of thunderstorms in late-August. Rainfall averaged 1.5-2.00 inches in the valley but on August 25th a heavy, near stationary thunderstorm over the Dead Mountains to the west created major flooding on the California farm. All of Field 26 including the 48.5 acres to be fallowed under the Plan was inundated for several weeks as was most of the Farm.

- Typically in the Mojave area, a year's small grain crop is seeded in the proceeding November with the expectation that the usual December rains will germinate the crop and it will be ready for the first actual irrigation in early January. This regimen was planned for Field 26 including the IOPP portion however heavy rains in late November necessitated a light irrigation in late December.
- The Fort Mojave Indian Tribe diverted 15,323 acre feet out of an approved order of 16,565 acre feet for the California Reservation in 2013.
