8 WPI II – Col Farm AZ, LLC (WPI) can utilize the Topock Marsh Inlet Canal to deliver 2,302 afy of MVIDD’s Colorado River water entitlement under Contract No. 14-06-W-204, as amended, dated November 14, 1968, as authorized by MVIDD, at a flow rate sufficient to service the pump(s) operated by WPI to irrigate certain lands within the state of Arizona and the MVIDD service area.
