As a consultant for the Navajo Nation with funding from the Environmental Defense Fund, I have had the opportunity to review the Colorado River Basin Water Supply and Demand Study, Interim Report No. 1.

In section 5.3.3, the report mentions an ongoing sensitivity analysis to compare the changes in evapotranspiration computation methodology (from modified Blaney-Criddle to Penman-Monteith) and its potential effects on agricultural demand projections. I would be very interested in reviewing this work.
