City of Yuma Land Conveyance Project



In accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, as amended, and based on the following, the Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation) has determined that implementation of the Proposed Action to convey land to the City of Yuma (COY) would not result in a significant impact on the quality of human health and the environment.

The attached Environmental Assessment (EA) provides details on the Proposed Action and an analysis of potential impacts and should be used as a companion document to this Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI).

The purpose of the Proposed Action is to exchange land between the two entities to assist in the organization of the City of Yuma's historic downtown area. The lands exchanged will consolidate the holdings of each entity.

Based on the analysis of the environmental impacts and conservation commitments, as presented in the EA, Reclamation finds no significant impact and recommends implementation of the Proposed Action to convey lands to the City of Yuma.
