Investing in America

- Invested \$946 million
- Created or Retained more than 10,200 jobs
- Six Priority Areas
 - Meeting Future Water Supply Needs - \$469.6 million
 - Improving Infrastructure Reliability and Safety - \$155.2 Million
 - Environmental and Ecosystem Restoration - \$220.1 Million
 - Water Conservation Initiative - \$38.2 Million
 - Green Buildings - \$19.5 Million
 - Emergency Drought Relief in the West - \$40.6 Million

- Invested \$469.6 Million
- Title XVI Projects - \$127 Million
- Rural Water Projects - \$241.6 Million
 - Completed Perkins County Rural Water Supply Project

Improving Infrastructure Reliability and Safety

- Invested \$155.2 million
- \$10.2 million to inspect canals in urban areas
- \$19.2 million to accelerate safety of dam risk reduction at Folsom Dam
- \$ 15.6 million to coat Flatiron Penstocks

Environmental and Ecosystem Restoration

- Invested \$220.1 Million
 - Red Bluff Fish Passage, \$112.6 Million
 - Contra Costa Fish Screen, \$26.3 Million
 - Yakima River Water Enhancement Project, \$21.5 Million
 - Battle Creek Salmon/Steelhead Restoration, \$12.7 Million

Water Conservation Initiative

- Invested \$38.2 Million in challenge grants to 13 projects
- Projects included
 - Antelope Valley Water Bank Initial Recharge and Recovery Facility Improvement Project (Calif.) - \$5 Million
 - Three Sisters Irrigation District Main Canal Pipeline Phase 1 (Ore.) - \$1.3 Million
 - Bear River Innovative Water Conservation Measurement for the Bear River Water District #11 (Idaho) - \$3.8 Million
 - Water Resources Sustainability Enhancements (Ariz.) - \$1.8 Million

Green Buildings

- Invested \$19.5 Million
- Green Building in Boulder City, Nevada
 - Uses 39 percent less water
 - 270 kilowatt solar farm
- Green Building as part of ALP Project

Emergency Drought Relief in the West

- Invested \$40.6 Million
- 29 Projects
- Projects Included
 - Del Puerto Water District (Calif.) – \$7.2 Million
 - Gray Lodge/Pixley Wildlife Refuge (Calif.) - \$5.1 Million
 - West Stanislaus Irrigation District (Calif.) - \$4.99 Million
