## **Secretary Salazar to Announce Innovations to Deal with Climate Change Impacts**

### ***3D Geospatial Presentation at Interior Command Center***

On Monday, Sept. 14, 2009, Secretary of the Interior Ken Salazar will announce structural innovations at the Department of the Interior that will enable it to more effectively monitor and manage its significant wildlife, land and water resources for the impacts of climate change. The presentation will detail Interior's national role in studying and responding to climate change in a 3-D geospatial presentation in the multimedia Interior Command Center. Salazar will sign a Secretarial Order implementing this initiative.

Credentialed news media representatives are invited to participate in the news conference at the command center with Secretary Salazar, Deputy Secretary David Hayes and other top Interior officials. A Q&A session will follow the presentation. A listen-only teleconference line is also available.
