F-1 <i>Lower Silver Creek Acquisition</i>  (BLM, Hollister)	Fee title acquisition of 240 contiguous acres of land to complete the protection of lands surrounding the confluence of Silver Creek & Panoche Creek (Lower Silver Creek) in Fresno County. Species to benefit include San Joaquin kit fox, giant kangaroo rat, and San Joaquin woolly-threads.	<b>\$240,000*</b>
F-2 <i>Arroyo Hondo Plateau Habitat Protection Project</i>  (BLM, Hollister)	Fee title acquisition of 280 acres on three parcels to promote protection of giant kangaroo rat habitat on the south side of Arroyo Hondo Plateau in Fresno County. Species to benefit include San Joaquin kit fox, giant kangaroo rat, and San Joaquin woolly-threads.	<b>\$168,000*</b>
F-3 <i>Stubblefield Ranch Acquisition Project</i>  (BLM, Bakersfield)	Fee title acquisition of a 1,615-acre property located at the southeastern end of the Carrizo Plain National Monument in Kern and San Luis Obispo counties. Species to benefit include San Joaquin kit fox, giant kangaroo rat, blunt-nosed leopard lizard, California jewelflower, Kern primrose sphinx moth, and California condor.	<b>\$28,970*</b>  (Note: the CVPCP is providing \$574,567. Total: \$603,537) CVPCP has approval to provide \$396,463 more in FY12/13.
<i>Acquisition of Habitat for Threatened and Endangered Species at Pixley National Wildlife Refuge</i>  (USFWS, Pixley NWR)	Fee title acquisition of 197.5 acres for inclusion in the Pixley NWR in Tulare County. Species to benefit include Tipton kangaroo rat, San Joaquin kit fox, and blunt-nosed leopard lizard.	<b>\$389,303**</b>
C-3 <i>Reintroduction of the Metcalf Canyon Jewelflower at Tulare Hill in Southern Santa Clara County</i>  (Santa Clara University)	The main objective is to reintroduce the Metcalf Canyon jewelflower at three sites on Tulare Hill, and supplement an existing population at Motorcycle County Park in Santa Clara County. Species to benefit is the Metcalf Canyon jewelflower.	<b>\$157,231*</b>  (Note: the CVPCP is providing \$115,737. Total: \$272,968)
