Dear Mr. Fujitani:

This is in response to your February 4, 2014, letter, where the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation) proposes to establish a Vernalis flow-to-combined export (I:E) ratio of 1:1 for April 1-May 31, 2014. Reasonable and prudent alternative (RPA) Action IV.2.1 in NOAA's National Marine Fisheries Service's (NMFS) biological and conference opinion on the long-term operation of the Central Valley Project (CVP) and State Water Project (SWP, page 70 of the 2009 RPA with 2011 amendments at CVP/SWP Opinion) limits the I:E ratio from April 1-May 31, depending on the San Joaquin Valley Classification of water year type.

NMFS acknowledges the current dry hydrology in the San Joaquin River Basin, and unlikelihood that it will change considerably in the coming months. NMFS understands that it is prudent to plan in advance and provide certainty in hydrology to accommodate water transfers. NMFS expects that the water transfers, to the extent that they increase flows down the San Joaquin River, will be beneficial to outmigrating salmonids. In consideration of the rationale you provided, NMFS agrees that early determination of the I:E ratio is warranted for this year. We appreciate your statement that you will coordinate further with us in coming months in the unlikely event that hydrologic conditions and runoff forecasts change substantially.
