Michelle Williams is Deputy Regional Director for Business Services of Bureau of Reclamation's California-Great Basin Region, a federal agency under Department of the Interior that delivers water and power to California, Nevada, and the Klamath Basin.

Williams was appointed deputy regional director in November 2019, serving as the Region's manager of Business Services, which oversees the divisions of Financial Management, Acquisition Services, Information Management, Administrative Services, and Human Resources.

Williams joins Reclamation from the Department of Commerce and U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, where she held various high-level program management positions and is the recipient of numerous awards including the 2017 Igniting Innovation Overall Winner Awards by the American
