Karl Stock, Regional Director



Karl Stock is the director of the Bureau of Reclamation's California-Great Basin Region. Reclamation is a federal agency under the Department of the Interior that delivers water and generates power across the 17 western states.

Appointed in January 2024, Stock leads the management, development and protection of water and related resources in the region, including one of the nation's largest and most complex water projects, the Central Valley Project. He oversees Oregon's Klamath Project, Nevada's Truckee Storage Project and California's Orland, Solano, Cachuma and Ventura River projects.

Stock joined Reclamation in 2001, serving in a variety of leadership positions, most recently as manager of the Reclamation Law Administration Division. In that capacity, he developed critical strategies for investing funds from the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law and the

Inflation Reduction Act to address water resources challenges in the western states.

Stock holds a bachelor's degree in economics from Brigham Young University and a master's degree in public administration from the University of Colorado Denver.
