- Operational Updates
 - CVP: Trinity River release is at 2,000 cfs today and will slowly decrease through August 4. Sacramento River (Keswick) release is 9,000 cfs. Clear Creek (Whiskeytown) release is 150 cfs; a 500 cfs pulse starts tomorrow reducing to 150 cfs by June 25. American River (Nimbus) release is 3,000 cfs and will increase to 3,500 cfs tomorrow. Stanislaus River (Goodwin) is currently releasing 1,500 cfs. Reclamation's Delta pumping is at 4,200 cfs (5 units). Federal share of San Luis Reservoir is 732 TAF.
 - SWP: Feather River (Oroville-Thermalito Complex) release is 3,800 cfs. Clifton Court Forebay exports are currently 1,700 cfs and adjusting with SJR inflows to maintain -5,000 cfs OMRI and supporting Delta Outflow for X2 days per D-1641. State share of San Luis Reservoir is at 414 TAF.
- Hydrology Update (from Outlook): A significant heat-up from the weekend will occur at the start of the week; temperatures will trend cooler late in the week.

Discussion Items

- Annual Consolitated Place of Use (CPOU) Petition for Temporary Change in Water Right:
 - May 24 email noticed a petition of temporary transfer to consolidate places of use (CPOU) of SWP and CVP. The action would transfer up to 428,300 AF water. The question is whether this petition relates to water operations, and whether this action was included in the 2019 Proposed Action and consultation.
 - SWRCB shared that similar petitions are received and processed every year, and it allows the projects to consolidate places of use south of Delta.
 - DWR confirmed that CPOU is an annual submittal. The actions in the petition are transfers and exchanges that take place south of Delta, and they would not result in any changes to the timing or amount of water diverted from the Delta. The transfers and exchanges that occur because of the CPOU are not associated with the transfer component of the 2019 Proposed Action or the 2020 Incidental Take Permit.
 - FWS and NMFS requested additional discussion on whether and how to include these types of nuances to the water transfer proposed action element in the ongoing consultation. DWR committed to circulating the complete CPOU package to WOMT and agreed to discuss internally and report back.
- Meeting schedule for WOMT after SaMT and SMT are no longer meeting:
 - Usual Wednesday meeting times will stay in place, but facilitator will reach out on Tuesdays to see if there is a need to meet. Any WOMT member can request to meet.
