 - Oct 1, 2016 NMFS issues Draft BO
 - Apr 1, 2017 Reclamation issues Draft EIS/Supplemental
 - Feb 1, 2018 NMFS issues Final BO
 - Feb 1, 2018 Reclamation issues Final EIS/supplemental
 - Apr 29, 2018 Reclamation signs Record Of Decision (ROD)

Ongoing EIS Efforts

- Prepare Affected Environment Sections
- Identify Alternatives
 - No Action Alternative
 - Second Basis of Comparison
 - Alternatives 1 6
 - All Alternatives compared to No Action Alternative and Second Basis of Comparison
 - All Alternatives include Sea Level Rise and Climate Change for 2030
 - Analyses will Consider Potential for Water Transfers
- Prepare Model Assumptions for Alternatives and Conduct Initial Model Runs

NEPA No Action Alternative and Second Basis of Comparison

- No Action Alternative
 - Continuation of Existing Policy and Management Direction in Year 2030
 - CVP and SWP Operations with RPA Actions
- Second Basis of Comparison
 - CVP and SWP Operations without RPA Actions

Alternatives 1 and 2

• Alternative 1

Same as Second Basis of Comparison

• Alternative 2

 Operational RPA Actions in BOs – Does Not Include RPA Actions that Require Construction

Alternative 3

Non-Operational Actions

- Predation Control, Habitat Restoration, Trap & Haul Fish Passage, Ocean Harvest Limits Revisions
- Operational Actions
 - Similar to Second Basis of Comparison
 - Old and Middle River Criteria (OMR)
 - Between -5,000 and -3,500 cfs Based on Turbidity (First Flush until Larval/Juvenile Action)
 - No more than -5,000 cfs Based on Presence of Delta Smelt (Larval/Juvenile Action until Jun 15, unless Qwest is Greater than 12,000 cfs, or Low Turbidity Conditions)

Alternative 4

- Same as Second Basis of Comparison
- Non-Operational Actions
 - Predation Control, Habitat Restoration, Trap & Haul Fish Passage, Ocean Harvest Limits Revisions, Additional Floodplain Development Limitations, Water Quality Improvements, Vegetation on Levees

Alternatives 5 and 6

• Alternative 5

- Similar to No Action Alternative
- Implementation of the RPA Actions Plus:
 - Enhanced Fall, Winter, and Spring Delta Outflow
 - Delta Cross Channel Operations per Pilot Study
 - Positive OMR in Oct Mar and Jun in All Years
 - Positive OMR in Apr May in Wet/Above Normal Years
 - No Delta Exports in Apr May in Below Normal/Dry/ Critical Years
- Alternative 6
 - Proposed Action for Section 7 Consultation
