Leave No Trace



Plan Ahead and Prepare

Leave No Trace is not just a good idea, it is often the law.*
Know local regulations and conditions and plan accordingly.
Firearms are prohibited.



Travel on Durable Surfaces

Camp only in established campgrounds.
Drive only on designated roads.



Dispose of Waste Properly

Pack it in, pack it out.
Use restrooms. When restrooms are unavailable, deposit solid human waste in catholes dug 6 inches deep, at least 200 feet from water and trails.



Leave What You Find

Leave natural and historic resources as you find them.
Avoid introducing or transporting non-native species like Yellow Star Thistle and Aquatic Mussels.
Preserve our forest by not tying ropes to trees.



Prevent Fires

Use electric or gas appliances with an on/off switch for cooking and light. Observe posted operating hours and pack up prior to sunset.



Respect Wildlife

Do not approach or feed wildlife. No hunting.
Clean up after your pet and keep them on a leash.



Be Considerate of Other Visitors

Let nature's sounds prevail and avoid using loud music.
Leave your drone at home.
Keep Berryessa smoke free and refrain from using substances like marijuana that impair driving.
