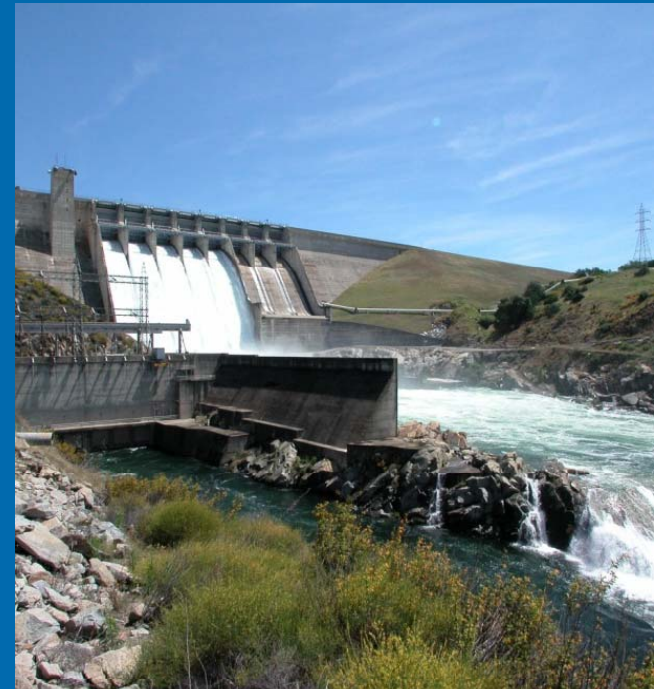

Project Description

- Shared facilities for:
 - Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation)
 - California Department of Water Resources (DWR)
 - National Weather Service (NWS)
- Relocate from existing interim Joint Operations Center (Existing JOC) at El Camino Road and Watt Avenue



Project Description

- Accommodate about 600 employees
- About 200,000 square feet
- Approximately 16 acres of land
- Preliminary design concepts

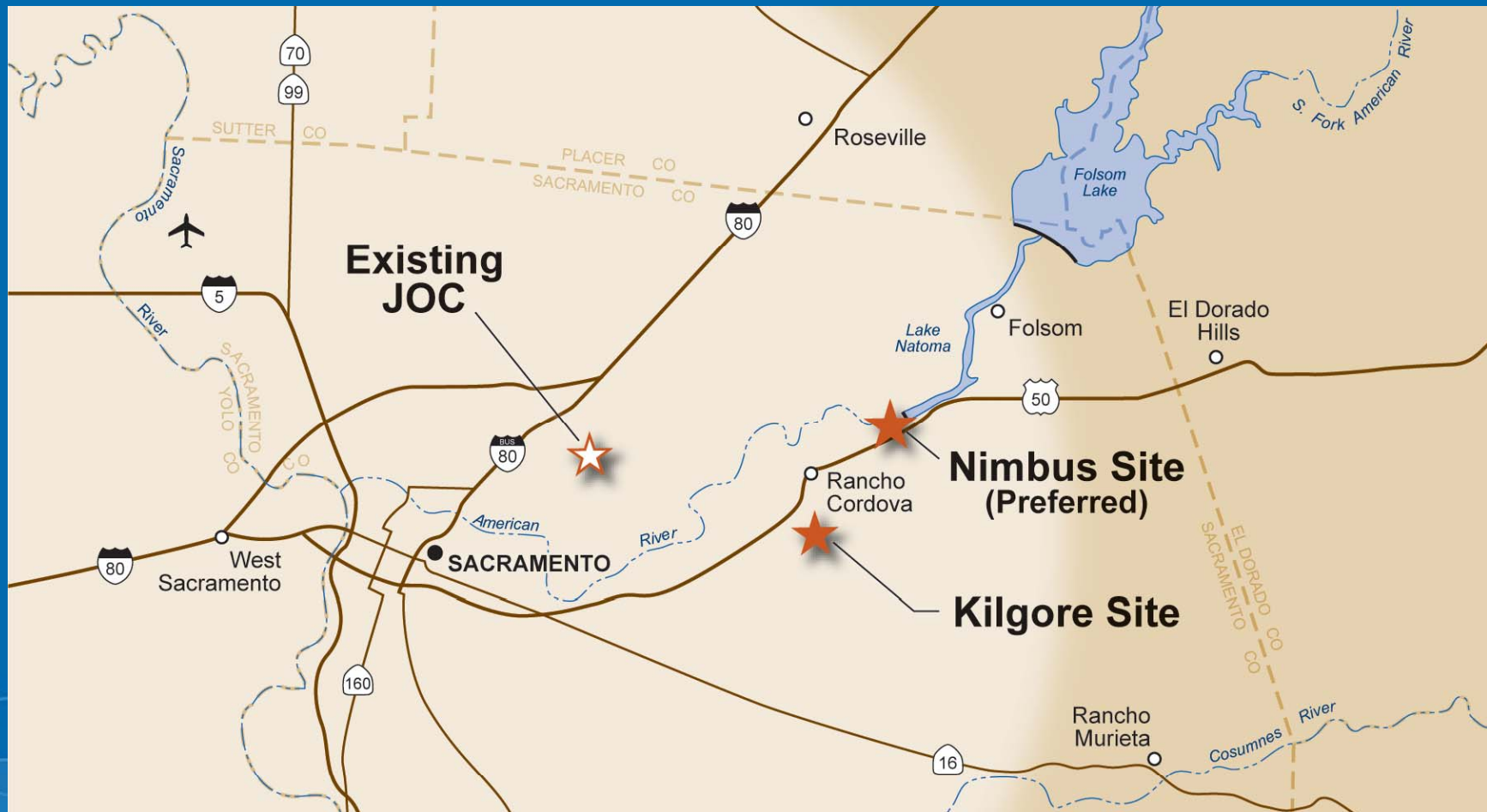


Why are we relocating?

- Existing JOC:
 - does not meet safety, physical security, and essential service requirements,
 - does not provide for future expansion, and
 - would require costly retrofit and remodel.
- The lease expires in June 2015



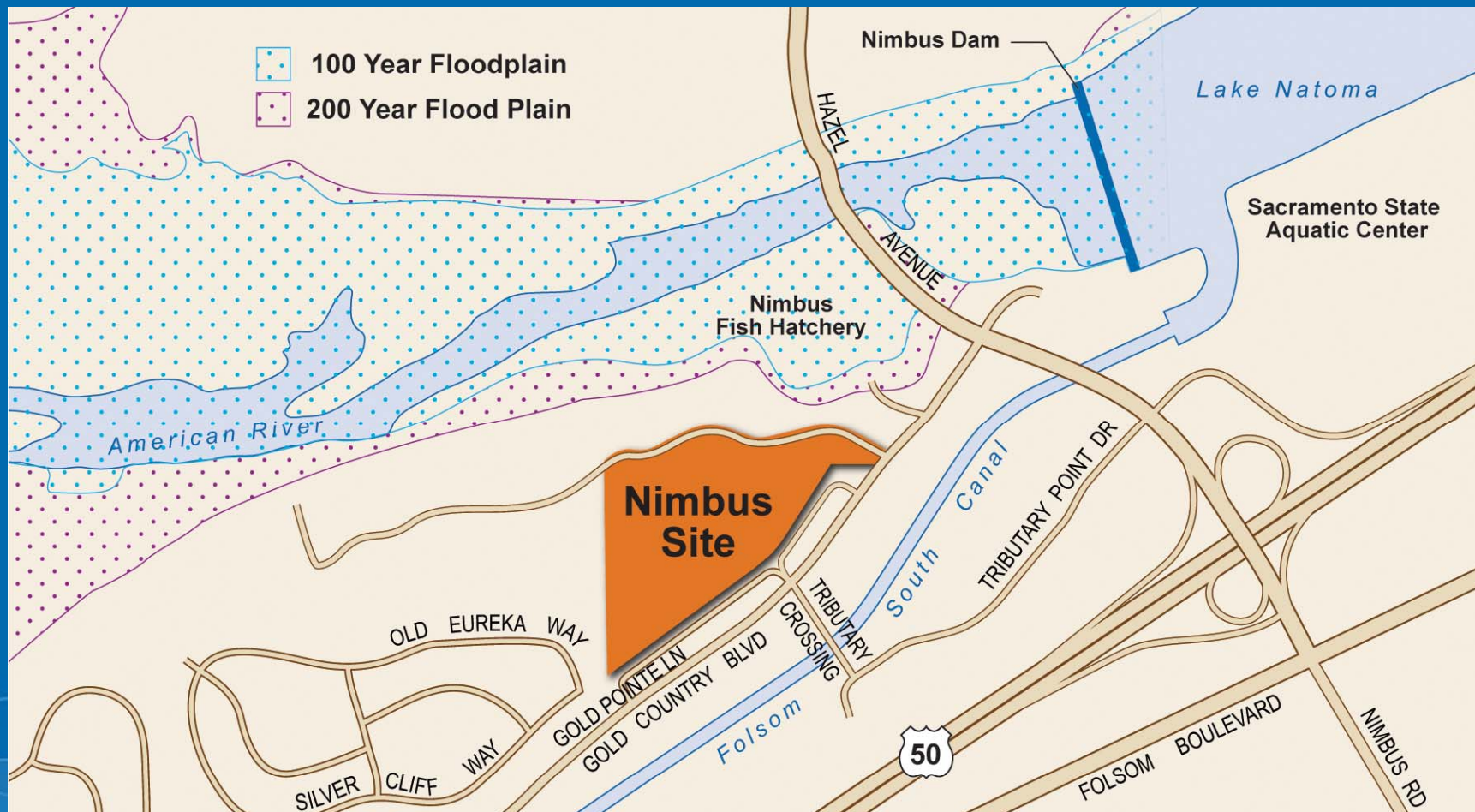

Within 20 minutes of headquarters



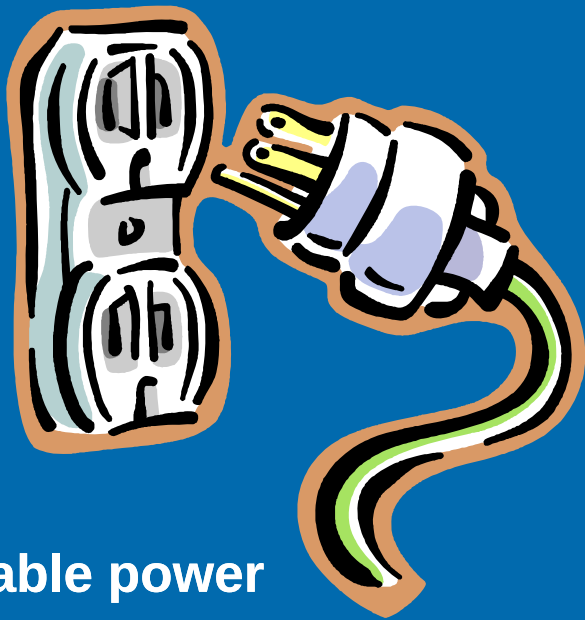
New location needs . . .

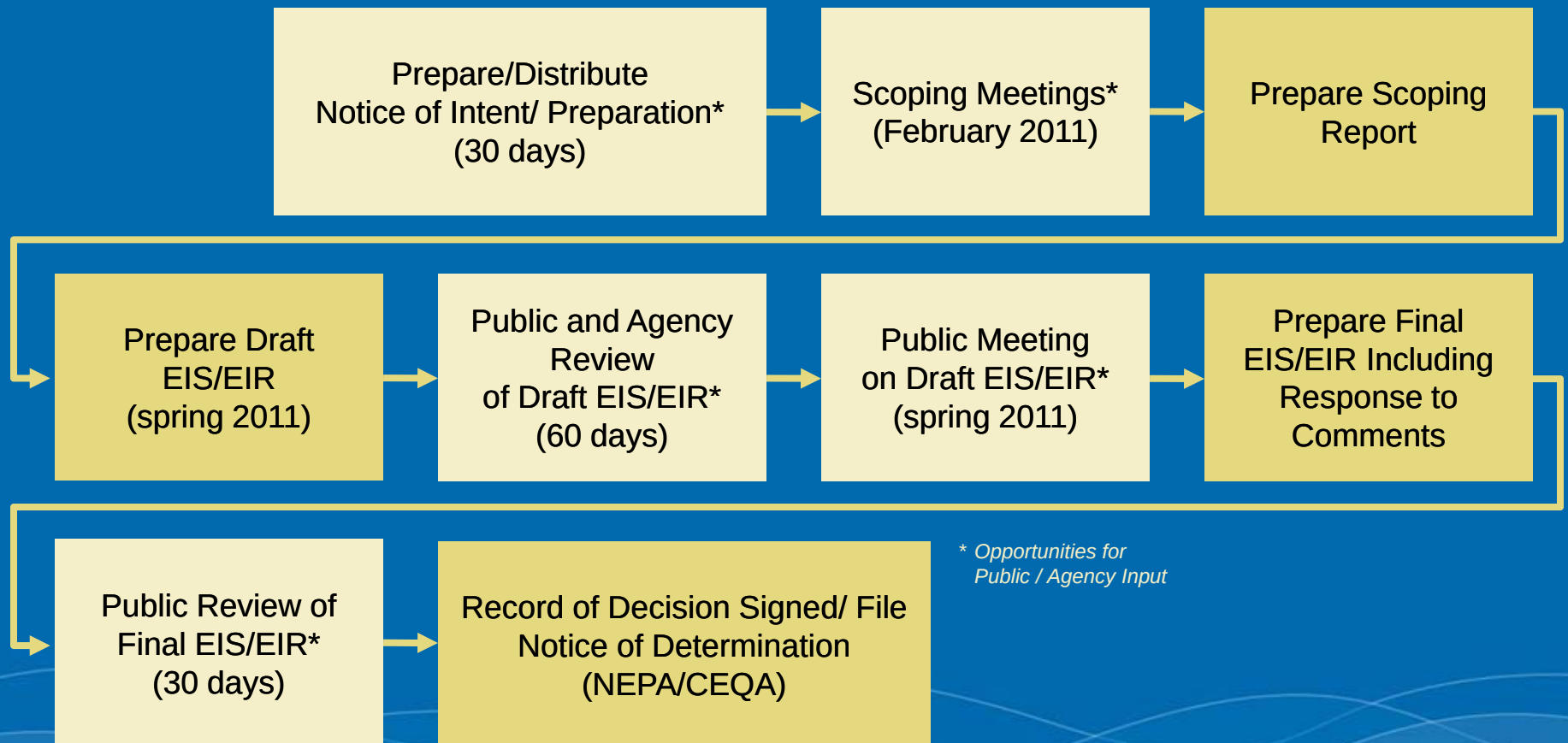
Access to public transportation



Alternative transportation

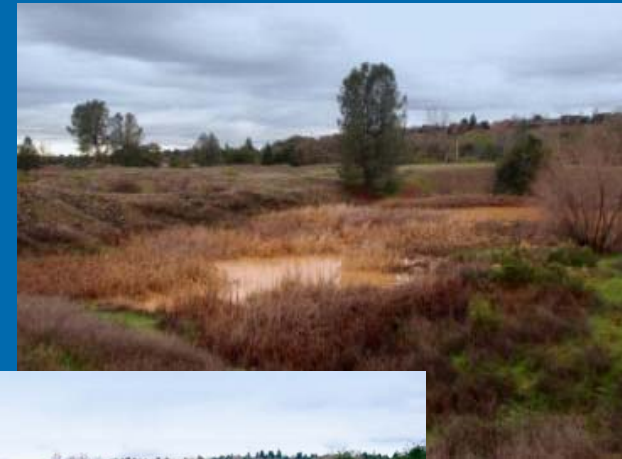


General Overview of NEPA/CEQA Process

- Key issues to be evaluated:
 - Biological resources
 - Cultural resources



Environmental Issues in the EIS/EIR

- Key issues to be evaluated:
 - Aesthetics/visual resources
 - Recreation
 - Traffic



Environmental Issues in the EIS/EIR

- Key issues to be evaluated:
 - Socioeconomics and environmental justice
 - Climate change
 - Cumulative impacts
 - No action alternative
