<p><i>Coyote Ridge Grazing Program for Serpentine Species</i></p> <p>Santa Clara Valley Open Space Authority</p>	<p>Habitat restoration across 4,160 acres on Coyote Ridge to benefit serpentine-dependent and aquatic species through enhancement of wetland and riparian habitats, and improvement of connectivity, via implementation of a grazing management plan. Species to benefit include California red-legged frog, California tiger salamander, bay checkerspot butterfly, Santa Clara Valley dudleya, Metcalf Canyon jewelflower, and Tiburon paintbrush.</p>	<p><b>\$131,124</b></p>
