16	THIS CONTRACT, made this27 <sup>th</sup> day of, 20 <u>04</u> , in			
17	pursuance generally of the Act of June 17, 1902 (32 Stat. 388), and acts amendatory or			
18	supplementary thereto, including, but not limited to, the acts of August 26, 1937 (50 Stat. 844), as			
19	amended and supplemented, August 4, 1939 (53 Stat. 1187), as amended and supplemented, July 2,			
20	1956 (70 Stat. 483), June 21, 1963 (77 Stat. 68), October 12, 1982 (96 Stat. 1263), as amended and			
21	Title XXXIV of the Act of October 30, 1992 (106 Stat. 4706), all collectively hereinafter referred to			
22	as Federal Reclamation law, between THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, hereinafter referred			
23	to as the United States, THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES OF THE STATE OF			
24	CALIFORNIA, hereinafter referred to as DWR, and COUNTY OF FRESNO, hereinafter referred			
25	to as the Contractor, a public agency of the State of California, duly organized, existing, and acting			
26	pursuant to the laws thereof, with its principal place of business in Fresno, California;			
27	WITNESSETH, That:			
28	EXPLANATORY RECITALS			
29	WHEREAS, the United States, DWR, and the Contractor entered into an interim			
30	renewal contract identified as Contract No. 14-06-200-8292A-IR5, hereinafter referred to as the			

31	Interim Renewal Contract, which provided for the continued water service to the Contractor		
32	following expiration of Contract No. 14-06-200-8292A; and		
33	WHEREAS, the United States, DWR, and the Contractor have entered into		
34	successive renewals of the Interim Renewal Contract, the most recent of which is Contract No. 14		
35	06-200-8292A-IR7, hereinafter referred to as the Existing Interim Renewal Contract from March		
36	2003, through February 29, 2004; and		
37	WHEREAS, the United States, DWR, and the Contractor have made significant		
38	progress in their negotiations of a long-term renewal contract, believe that further negotiations on		
39	the long-term renewal contract would be beneficial, and mutually commit to continue to negotiate		
40	to seek to reach agreement, but anticipate that the environmental documentation necessary for		
41	execution of any long-term renewal contract will be delayed at least an additional 7 months, and		
42	may be delayed further for reasons beyond the control of the parties; and		
43	WHEREAS, the Contractor has requested a subsequent interim renewal contract		
44	pursuant to Subdivision (b)(1) of Article 2 of the Interim Renewal Contract and Article 1 of the		
45	Existing Interim Renewal Contract; and		
46	WHEREAS, the United States has determined that the Contractor has to date		
47	fulfilled all of its obligations under the Existing Interim Renewal Contract; and		
48	WHEREAS, the United States is willing to renew the Existing Interim Renewal		
49	Contract pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth below;		
50	NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual and dependent covenants		
51	herein contained, it is hereby mutually agreed by the parties hereto as follows:		

## 52 INCORPORATION AND REVISION OF EXISTING INTERIM RENEWAL CONTRACT

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- 1. The terms and conditions of the Existing Interim Renewal Contract are hereby incorporated by reference into this Contract with the same force and effect as if they were included in full text with the exception of Article 1 thereof, which is revised as follows:
  - (a) The first sentence in Subdivision (a) of Article 1 of the Existing Interim

    Renewal Contract is modified as follows: "This interim renewal contract shall be effective from

    March 1, 2004, and shall remain in effect through February 28, 2005, and thereafter will be renewed

    as described in Subdivision (a) of Article 2 of the Interim Renewal Contract."
- 60 (b) Subdivision (b) of Article 1 of the Existing Interim Renewal Contract is 61 amended by deleting the date "February 15, 2004," and replacing same with the date 62 "February 15, 2005."
- 63 (c) Subdivision (c) of Article 1 of the Existing Interim Renewal Contract is 64 amended by deleting the dates "February 1, 2004," "February 15, 2004," and "February 29, 2004," 65 and replacing same with the dates "February 1, 2005," "February 15, 2005," and "February 28, 66 2005," respectively.
