16	THIS CONTRACT, made this 4 <sup>th</sup> day of May, 20 <u>04</u> , in		
17	pursuance generally of the Act of June 17, 1902 (32 Stat. 388), and acts amendatory or		
18	supplementary thereto, including, but not limited to, the acts of August 26, 1937 (50 Stat. 844), as		
19	amended and supplemented, August 4, 1939 (53 Stat. 1187), as amended and supplemented, July 2,		
20	1956 (70 Stat. 483), June 21, 1963 (77 Stat. 68), October 12, 1982 (96 Stat. 1263), as amended and		
21	Title XXXIV of the Act of October 30, 1992 (106 Stat. 4706), all collectively hereinafter referred to		
22	as Federal Reclamation law, between THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, hereinafter referred		
23	to as the United States, THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES OF THE STATE OF		
24	CALIFORNIA, hereinafter referred to as DWR, and TRI-VALLEY WATER DISTRICT,		
25	hereinafter referred to as the Contractor, a public agency of the State of California, duly organized,		
26	existing, and acting pursuant to the laws thereof, with its principal place of business in Sanger,		
27	California;		

1	WITNESSETH, That:		
2	EXPLANATORY RECITALS		
3	WHEREAS, the United States, DWR, and the Contractor entered into an interim		
4	renewal contract identified as Contract No. 14-06-200-8565A-IR5, hereinafter referred to as the		
5	Interim Renewal Contract, which provided for the continued water service to the Contractor		
6	following expiration of Contract No. 14-06-200-8565A; and		
7	WHEREAS, the United States, DWR, and the Contractor have entered into		
8	successive renewals of the Interim Renewal Contract, the most recent of which is Contract No. 14-		
9	06-200-8565A-IR7, hereinafter referred to as the Existing Interim Renewal Contract from March 1,		
10	2003, through February 29, 2004; and		
11	WHEREAS, the United States, DWR, and the Contractor have made significant		
12	progress in their negotiations of a long-term renewal contract, believe that further negotiations on		
13	the long-term renewal contract would be beneficial, and mutually commit to continue to negotiate		
14	to seek to reach agreement, but anticipate that the environmental documentation necessary for		
15	execution of any long-term renewal contract will be delayed at least an additional 7 months, and		
16	may be delayed further for reasons beyond the control of the parties; and		
17	WHEREAS, the Contractor has requested a subsequent interim renewal contract		
18	pursuant to Subdivision (b)(1) of Article 2 of the Interim Renewal Contract and Article 1 of the		
19	Existing Interim Renewal Contract; and		
20	WHEREAS, the United States has determined that the Contractor has to date		
21	fulfilled all of its obligations under the Existing Interim Renewal Contract; and		
22	WHEREAS, the United States is willing to renew the Existing Interim Renewal		
23	Contract pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth below;		
24	NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual and dependent covenants		
25	herein contained, it is hereby mutually agreed by the parties hereto as follows:		

## INCORPORATION AND REVISION OF EXISTING INTERIM RENEWAL CONTRACT

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- 1. The terms and conditions of the Existing Interim Renewal Contract are hereby incorporated by reference into this Contract with the same force and effect as if they were included in full text with the exception of Article 1 thereof, which is revised as follows:
- 30 (a) The first sentence in Subdivision (a) of Article 1 of the Existing Interim
  31 Renewal Contract is modified as follows: "This interim renewal contract shall be effective from
  32 March 1, 2004, and shall remain in effect through February 28, 2005, and thereafter will be renewed
  33 as described in Subdivision (a) of Article 2 of the Interim Renewal Contract."
- 34 (b) Subdivision (b) of Article 1 of the Existing Interim Renewal Contract is 35 amended by deleting the date "February 15, 2004," and replacing same with the date 36 "February 15, 2005."
- 37 (c) Subdivision (c) of Article 1 of the Existing Interim Renewal Contract is 38 amended by deleting the dates "February 1, 2004," "February 15, 2004," and "February 29, 2004," 39 and replacing same with the dates "February 1, 2005," "February 15, 2005," and "February 28, 40 2005," respectively.
