13	THIS CONTRACT, made this27 th day of February, 20 <u>04</u> , in		
14	pursuance generally of the Act of June 17, 1902 (32 Stat. 388), and acts amendatory or supplementary		
15	thereto, including, but not limited to, the acts of August 26, 1937 (50 Stat. 844), as amended and		
16	supplemented, August 4, 1939 (53 Stat. 1187), as amended and supplemented, July 2, 1956 (70 Stat.		
17	483), June 21, 1963 (77 Stat. 68), October 12, 1982 (96 Stat. 1263), as amended and Title XXXIV of		
18	the Act of October 30, 1992 (106 Stat. 4706), all collectively hereinafter referred to as Federal		
19	Reclamation law, between THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, hereinafter referred to as the		
20	United States, and THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS, hereinafter

23	EXPLANATORY RECITALS		
24	WHEREAS, the United States and the Contractor entered into an interim renewal		
25	contract identified as Contract No. 3-07-20-W1124-R, hereinafter referred to as the Interim Renewal		
26	Contract, which provided for the continued water service from March 1, 2003, to February 29, 2004, to		
27	the Contractor following expiration of Contract No. 3-07-20-W1124; and		
28	WHEREAS, the United States and the Contractor have made significant progress in		
29	their negotiations of a long-term renewal contract, believe that further negotiations on the long-term		

30 renewal contract would be beneficial, and mutually commit to continue to negotiate to seek to reach 31 agreement, but anticipate that the environmental documentation necessary for execution of any 32 long-term renewal contract will be delayed at least an additional 7 months, and may be delayed 33 further for reasons beyond the control of the parties; and 34 WHEREAS, the Contractor has requested a subsequent interim renewal contract 35 pursuant to Subdivision (a) of Article 2 of the Interim Renewal Contract; and 36 WHEREAS, the United States has determined that the Contractor has to date 37 fulfilled all of its obligations under the Interim Renewal Contract; and 38 WHEREAS, the United States is willing to renew the Interim Renewal Contract 39 pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth below; 40 NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual and dependent covenants 41 herein contained, it is hereby mutually agreed by the parties hereto as follows: 42 INCORPORATION AND REVISION OF EXISTING INTERIM RENEWAL CONTRACT 43 1. The terms and conditions of the Interim Renewal Contract are hereby incorporated by reference into this Contract with the same force and effect as if they were included in full text 44 45 and is revised as follows: 46 (a) The first sentence in Subdivision (a) of Article 2 of the Interim

Renewal Contract is modified as follows: "This interim renewal contract shall be effective from

March 1, 2004, and shall remain in effect through February 28, 2006, and thereafter will be renewed

as described in Subdivision (a) of Article 2 of the Interim Renewal Contract if a long-term renewal

contract has not been executed with an effective commencement date of March 1, 2006; Provided,

that if a long-term renewal contract has been executed with an effective commencement date of

March 1, 2005, this interim renewal contract shall expire on February 28, 2005."
