CONFIRMATION OF CONTRACT

The Contractor, after the execution of this contract, shall promptly seek to secure a decree of a court of competent jurisdiction of the State of California, confirming the execution of this contract. The Contractor shall furnish the United States a certified copy of the final decree, the validation proceedings, and all pertinent supporting records of the court approving and confirming this contract, and decreeing and adjudging it to be lawful, valid, and binding on the Contractor. This contract shall not be binding on the United States until such final decree has been secured.

The confirmation article is required by Section 1 of the Act of May 15, 1922, (42 Stat. 541), and Section 46 of the Omnibus Adjustment Act of 1926 (44 Stat. 649). These acts require court confirmation of contract before water is delivered or construction initiated.
