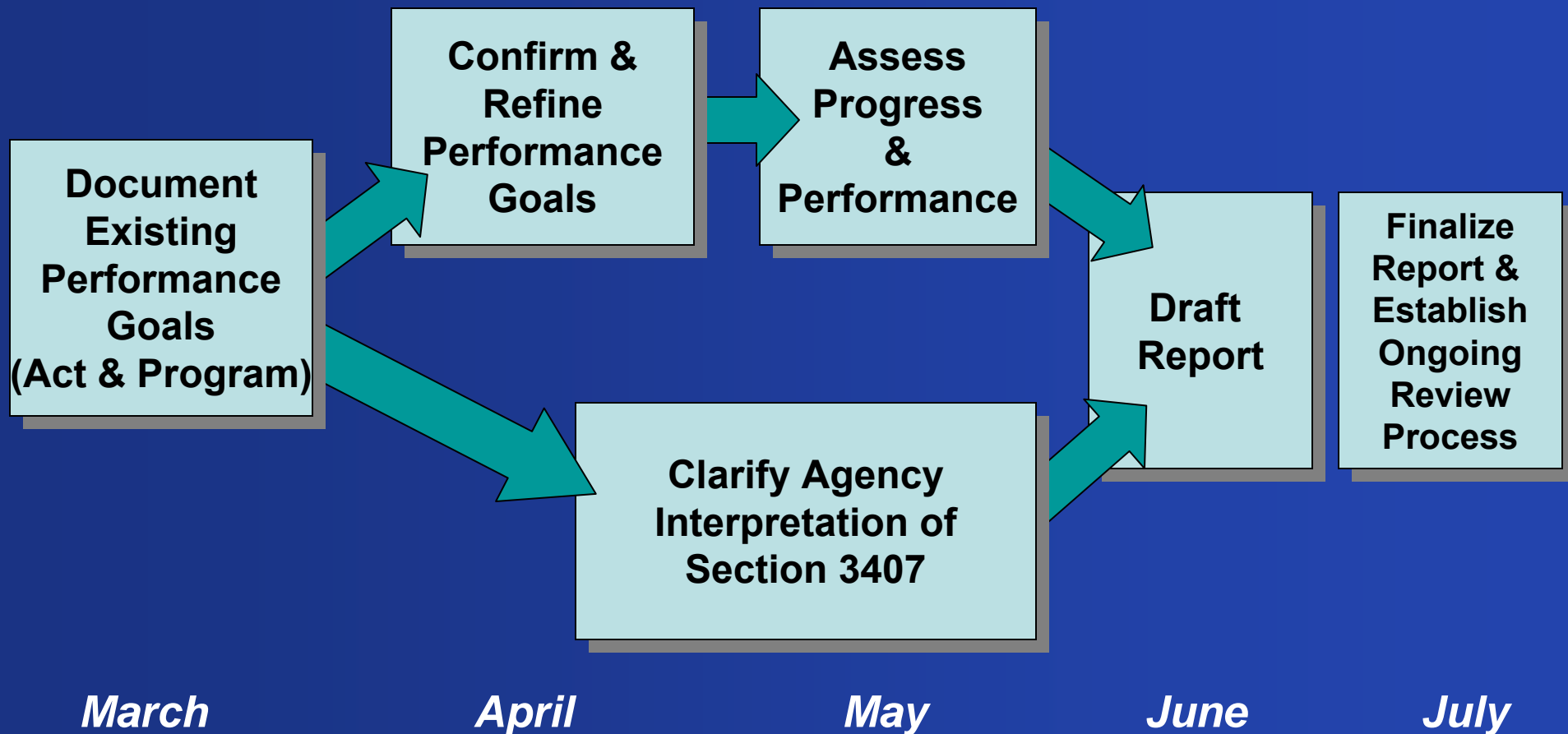
Draft Purpose Statement

- The purpose of the Central Valley Project Improvement Act (Act) Program Activity Review is to define completion criteria, clarify performance goals, and assess the status and progress of the Section 3406 and 3408 provisions of the Act.
 - **The Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation) and Fish and Wildlife Service (Service) will conduct this Program Activity Review with other federal, tribal, and state agencies, stakeholders, and other interested parties.**
- Reclamation and the Service will prepare a document summarizing the results of the Program Activity Review by July 2006.
 - **The document will contain: implementation status and achievements to date; summarized perspectives and conclusions; and agency recommendations.**

Ground Rules

- **Participate Fully**
 - Ask for what you need from the meeting process and participants
