Subject: Fiscal Year 2002 Water Deliveries and Revenue for Central Valley Project (CVP) Water

Dear Water Contractor:

The Bureau of Reclamation is in the preliminary stages of preparing the Results of Operations for Fiscal Year 2002, for individual CVP Irrigation and Municipal and Industrial (M&I) contractors. To prepare these accountings as accurately as possible, it is critical that Reclamation has reliable water delivery and revenue data. This data serves as the basis for the annual operation and maintenance expense allocation to each contractor and for determining their net surplus or deficit for the year.

In this regard, Reclamation requests your input to ensure the accuracy of our recorded data. We have enclosed a copy of your Water Deliveries and Revenues Report (WDR) showing water deliveries and revenues for the period October 1, 2001, through September 30, 2002. Please note that throughout the year this information has been provided to your organization monthly by Reclamation's respective area office in the form of a Water Delivery and Charges report or variation thereof. We are providing the information in a summarized WDR for the period ending September 30, 2002, to allow you one additional opportunity to review the data and identify any potential errors or omissions.

Please indicate on the enclosed WDR that the information is correct or not correct and explain any discrepancies. Due to the approaching holidays, the standard review period has been extended to 45 days from the date of this letter. Please return the WDR to us no later than January 16, 2003, by fax at (916) 978-5392 or in the envelope provided. Any discrepancies reported to Reclamation will be reviewed on an individual basis and resolved and discussed with you, as appropriate. **PLEASE NOTE**, that any response(s) after the 45-day period, regardless of validity, will not be considered for adjustment until the following year's accounting.
