Subject: Statement of Central Valley Project (CVP) Cumulative Municipal and Industrial (M&I) Operations for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 2004

Dear Water Contractor:

Enclosed is a statement of the cumulative financial results of operations applicable to your CVP M&I water service contract as of September 30, 2004. This statement is provided for informational purposes and is not a bill. It should not be confused with our August 15, 2005, notification letter providing a 30-day period to voluntarily pay off all or a portion of either your operation and maintenance or unpaid capital interest deficit(s) as recalculated under the recent M&I litigation settlement.

The statement shows the beginning cumulative balances from the prior fiscal year, an adjustment to the prior year ending balances due to the recent M&I litigation settlement, the current fiscal year results of operations, the ending capital repayment and deficit balances, as applicable, as of September 30, 2004. The statement reflects interest accrued and voluntary payments through fiscal year 2004.

As indicated above, the enclosed statement is provided for informational purposes only and is not a bill. However, if you wish to voluntarily reimburse the Bureau of Reclamation for all or a portion of your deficit(s), if any, please contact Ms. Masako Altman at 916-978-5365 to determine the appropriate payoff amount as interest continues to accrue from September 30, 2004, until Reclamation receives payment. Such payments should be remitted to the Bureau of Reclamation, Mid-Pacific Region, P.O. Box 894242, Los Angeles, CA 90189-4242. A copy of the documents supporting the payment should also be sent to the attention of Ms. Altman at the Bureau of Reclamation's Mid-Pacific Regional Office, 2800 Cottage Way – MP-3400, Sacramento, CA 95825-1898. Please state that the payment is to be applied to your deficit account on your transmittal and remittance.
