

## **Lake Berryessa Park Ranger Mike McGraw to Speak on the Solano Project at the Putah Creek Council's July 18 "CreekSpeak" in Davis, Calif.**

The public is invited to attend the Putah Creek Council's July 2013 "CreekSpeak" at 7 p.m. Thursday, July 18, at the Veterans Memorial Theater Club Room, 203 East 14th Street, Davis.

Lake Berryessa Park Ranger Mike McGraw will speak on "Water and Wilderness: A Tale of Conflict and Conservation." The informal CreekSpeak talks usually conclude about 8:30 p.m.

Ranger McGraw will discuss water in the West, specifically Putah Creek and Lake Berryessa, and how attitudes about resource use have changed. He will also tell the story of how Putah Creek, the Bureau of Reclamation and the Solano Project serve the water needs of the local community.

This is the third of six CreekSpeak presentations, the Putah Creek Council's six-month series of community talks about the region's nature, culture and history. The talks are free to Putah Creek Council members. A \$5 donation is requested from attendees who are not Council members.
