The Aerospace Museum of California will celebrate Armed Forces Day. A brief ceremony honoring the troops in conjunction with a Dedication Ceremony of the McClellan Memorial Rose Garden will be held in the Air Park at 11am, followed by a United States Coast Guard C-130 flyby.

In honor of Armed Forces Day, the Museum will also be hosting an Open Cockpit Day where children of all ages can explore, climb into, or imagine what it would be like to soar through the skies in several of the many aircraft on the ramp. Guests will experience historic planes and displays representing over eight decades of aviation history, as well as a chance to view thrilling jets like a US Navy Blue Angels' fighter, A-10 Thunderbolt, or a famous 'Top Gun' F-14 Tomcat just like the movie.

Activities are planned throughout the day, including an interactive remote control aircraft display by Mather Aerospace Modelers. Support 4 Soldiers, where attendees can color pictures, sign cards and flags for troops overseas. Guests will also have the opportunity to meet and speak with local Tuskegee Airmen, and author, Len Kovar, *WWII Prisoner of War, How I Survived*.

Armed Forces Day officially starts with Opening Ceremonies on Friday, May 20th at 6 p.m. on the Mineral County High School football field at the corner of 5th and "A" Streets in Hawthorne.

Ceremonies include National Veterans of Foreign Wars Sr. Vice Commander Rich Denoyer's dedication of the American Veterans Traveling Tribute (AVTT) exhibit which includes statistics from every war and conflict in which the U.S. has been involved, and Nevada Governor Brian Sandoval's dedication of the Freedom Range.

Perhaps the most familiar tribute you'll see included in the AVTT is the Traveling Vietnam Wall, an 80% replica (the largest) of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Washington D.C.

The AVTT display will remain at the football field through 1 p.m. Sun., May 22 and is available for viewing 24 hours a day.

## **A Parade & So Much More**

The impressive parade during Armed Forces Day usually gets most of the town to the route each year, but this year nobody will miss it.

This year, 21 year-old career Army SPEC 4 Timothy M. Hall, who grew up in Hawthorne and lost both his legs and his right hip in Afghanistan in June of last year, is the Grand Marshall. He'll take a break from his two-year rehab at Walter Reed Medical Center to be honored in his hometown parade.

Cecil the Serpent, a twelve-foot-tall, 100-foot-long Hawthorne mascot based on a Paiute legend of Walker Lake, is a parade favorite and he will be on hand to keep kids of all ages happy.
