Managing Water in the West

Lake Berryessa, 70 miles northeast of San Francisco and 40 miles west of Sacramento, offers year-round recreation. The lake's water reaches temperatures of up to 75 degrees in the summer, making it an ideal place for water sports. Anglers enjoy fishing for both cold and warm water species, such as rainbow trout, bass, catfish, crappie and bluegill. Reclamation provides two free public areas, Oak Shores and Smittle Creek Day Use Areas, which offer picnic tables, barbeque grills, hiking trails, off-shore fishing, and beach-related activities.

The Markley Cove Resort Marina, built in 1959, is located adjacent to Highway 128 at the south end of Lake Berryessa. The marina has stores that provide rental boats, bait and tackle, clothing, sunscreen, food and drinks, towels, and other convenience items. Visitors can enjoy the beautiful oak and pine trees, swimming, picnicking, and water skiing.
