FIRE PREVENTION ORDER STAGE 1 FIRE RESTRICTIONS

**BUREAU OF RECLAMATION
LAHONTAN BASIN AREA OFFICE
NEWLANDS PROJECT AREA**

The following Stage 1 fire restrictions specified below are prohibited on the Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation) lands within the AREA DESCRIBED in the Newlands Project, Lahontan Basin Area Office, **effective at 12:01 AM on Monday, June 22, 2026**, and expiring on October 31, 2026, unless otherwise rescinded. The restricted area is depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

RESTRICTIONS:

- Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire (using wood, charcoal, or any other material), campfire, or stove fire except a portable stove using gas, jellied petroleum, or pressurized liquid fuel outside of a developed fee campground or picnic area (except by permit).
- Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building, a developed recreation site, or when stopped in an area at least 3 feet in diameter that is barren or cleared of all flammable material.
- Operating or parking a vehicle or other motorized equipment over or on top of dried/cured vegetation.
- Welding, metal grinding, or operating an acetylene or other torch with open flame (except by permit).
- Use of tracer rounds (always prohibited), steel-core ammunition, or exploding targets, including Binary Explosive Targets while recreational shooting.
- Operating a motor vehicle or combustion engine equipment without a spark arrestor (43 CFR §420.11(b)).
- Possessing, discharging, using, or allowing the use of fireworks, pyrotechnic or incendiary devices (43 CFR §423.30(c)).
- Reclamation supports the Bureau of Land Management Fire Restrictions; therefore, the greater restriction is in effect.

EXEMPTIONS:

An exemption does not absolve an individual or organization from liability or responsibility for any fire started by the exempted activity.

- Persons with a written permit that specifically authorizes the otherwise prohibited act.

- Any federal, state, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force, in the performance of an official duty.

ACTS RECOMMENDED BY FIRE PREVENTION ORDER: Possession of shovel, fire extinguisher, and/or at least 5 gallons of water should be on hand in the event of an unintentional fire start.

AREA DESCRIBED: Pursuant to Title 43 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Parts 423 and 429, this order applies to Reclamation-administered lands within the Newlands Project boundary administered by the Lahontan Basin Area Office in Churchill, Lyon, Storey, and Washoe counties. Lands excepted which are managed by other agencies include: the Lahontan State Recreation Area, Fallon National Wildlife Refuge, and Stillwater National Wildlife Refuge.

PURPOSE: This Order is necessary to protect public health and safety due to drying vegetation, increasing daytime temperatures, and threat of a wildfire.

IMPLEMENTATION: This Order will be in effect on June 22, 2026, and remain in effect until October 31, 2026, or until rescinded, whichever occurs first.

Under section (1)(a) of Public Law 107-69, you are subject to a fine under chapter 227, subchapter C of title 18 United States Code (18 U.S.C. 3571) or can be imprisoned for not more than 6 months, or both, if you violate these restrictions.

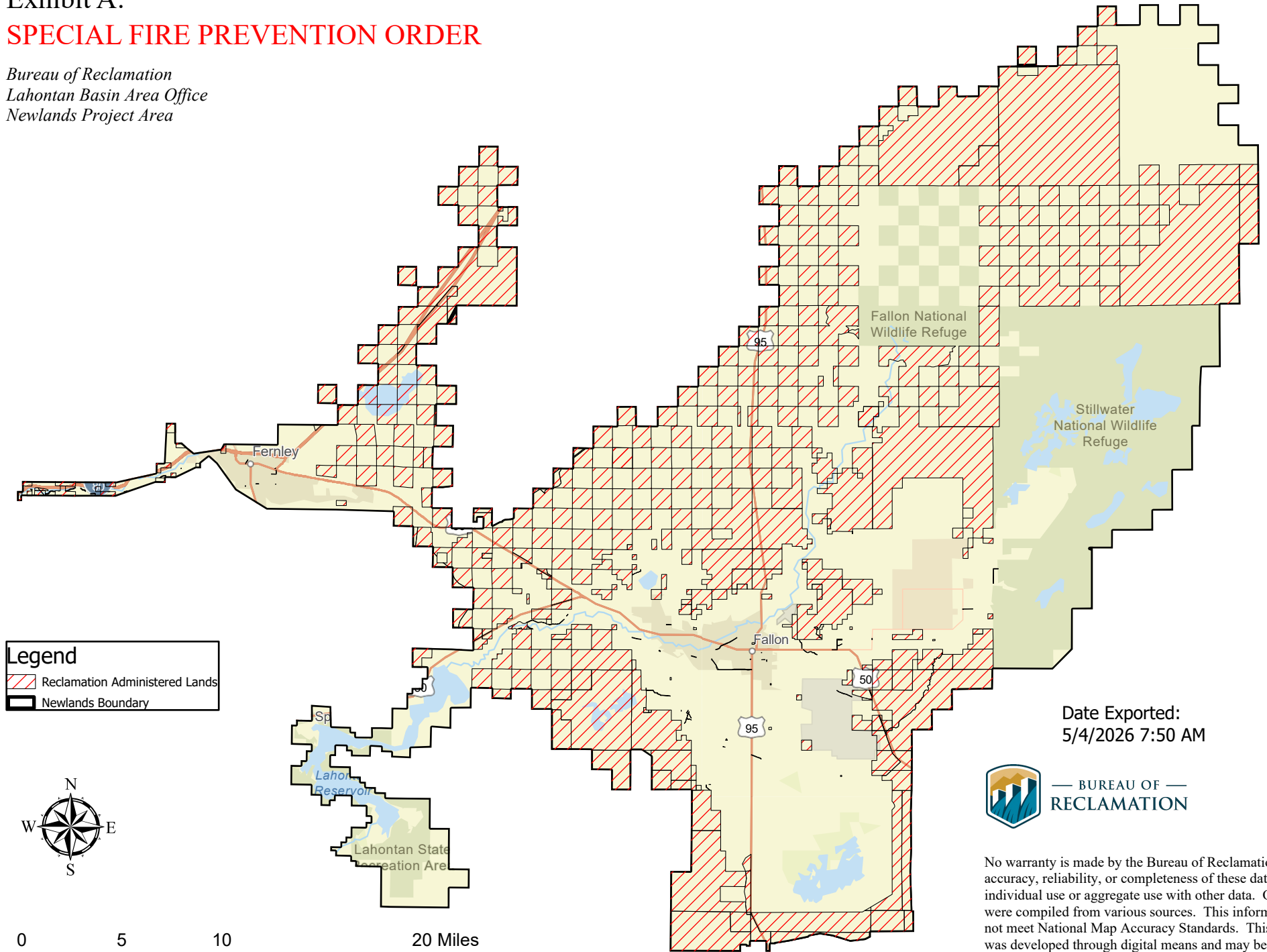
