

Reclamation Joins in the 22nd Annual Return of the Salmon Festival

The Bureau of Reclamation's Northern California Area Office will participate in the 22nd annual *Return of the Salmon Festival*. The festival will be held from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Saturday, October 20, at the Coleman National Fish Hatchery near Anderson, Calif., about 20 miles southeast of Redding.

The annual event celebrates the return of fall-run Chinook salmon and historically has drawn crowds larger than 10,000 people. Adults and kids alike will be able to view large numbers of fall-run Chinook salmon returning to Battle Creek and the hatchery. All aspects of day-to-day hatchery operations such as spawning, egg incubation and juvenile rearing, plus the salmon aquarium and natural resource information booths, will highlight the day's event.
