

All action alternatives include raising Shasta Dam and appurtenant features from 6.5 feet to as much as 18.5 feet. Enlarging the reservoir would require relocation, modification, or construction of structural features around the shoreline. Major relocations and modifications include bridges, roads, and recreation facilities. Several small dikes would also be needed to protect segments of highway and railroad routes.
