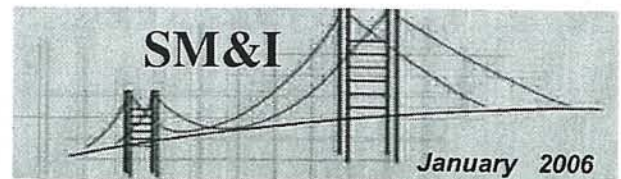

Commission responded to the sub-consultant's request for a sacred lands file search and list of Native American contacts for the project area as it was known at the time. The sacred lands file search failed to indicate the presence of Native American cultural resources in the immediate project area. However, commission staff recommended that other sources of information should be consulted for information. Commission staff also indicated that by contacting all those listed by the commission for this particular project, the sub-consultant would be better able to respond to claims of failure to consult with the appropriate tribe or group. If a response has not been received from one or more of the contacts, the commission's staff recommended a follow-up telephone call to insure that project information had been received by the contact(s).

November 28, 2011

The Commission responded to the sub-consultant's request for a second sacred lands file search to include an additional project area unknown to the sub-consultant when the first request for a sacred lands file search was made to the commission. The second search also failed to indicate the presence of Native American cultural resources. The commission included with its letter report, a second list of Native American contacts. The second list has fewer contacts than the first list, although the names on the second list are also included in the first list.
