Reclamation proposes to approve the addition of TMR as a point of delivery for the Madera Irrigation District's Soquel water under Contract No. 10-WC-20-3984B and the delivery of groundwater pumped from Flyin' J Ranch to TMR under Warren Act Contract No. 15-WC-20-4686. These contracts were previously analyzed by Reclamation, under EA-11-016 and EA-14-019, respectively.

Reclamation has determined that the amendment of the previously approved contracts to include these changes to points of delivery is the type of undertaking that has no potential to cause effects on historic properties, should such historic properties be present, pursuant to the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA) Section 106 regulations as codified at 36 CFR § 800.3(a)(1).
