

Pursuant to Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation) commitment on inclusions and exclusions presented on pages 2-40 and 2-57 of the Biological Opinion on Implementation of the Central Valley Project Improvement Act and Continued Operation and Maintenance of the Central Valley Project (CVP) (1-1-01-1-0311), Reclamation is hereby notifying the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (Service) of an exclusion. On August 26, 2010 KTWD revised their sphere of influence with the Kern County Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) (Figure 1). KTWD has requested Reclamation change KTWD's contractor service area (Table 1). This action will only affect the provider (e.g. KTWD) of water delivered to the subject area. KTWD's request excludes ~ 124.43 acres within its service boundary area and Reclamation's action is the approval of the exclusion. There will be no changes to existing facilities as a result of the exclusion.

Reclamation has made a No Effect determination under the Endangered Species Act (16 U.S.C. §1531 et. seq.) for the proposed federal action of approving this exclusion.
