

1. Water Control means the entity with operational control. Where identified as shared, means SPA/Reclamation in close coordination
2. Water Owner means the party in contractual possession of Sites Water at the Water Location. It is recognized that the SPA at all times retains ownership and responsibility for the Sites Water Right, Decision #XXXX
3. Liability means loss of water and/or financial loss from facility failure, outage, etc. SPA redirects allocation of all liabilities incurred across all those Storage Partners diverting, storing or releasing water at the time of loss.

Water Losses means losses of Sites water from seepage, evaporation, spillage, theft etc. SPA redirects allocation of all losses incurred across all those Storage Partners diverting, storing or releasing water at the time of loss.
