<b>3- Description of supplies or services required to meet the agency's needs</b>	
Reclamation has security management responsibilities for Canyon Ferry Dam and Powerplant and the lands that immediately surround Canyon Ferry Reservoir. Under 43 USCS 373e, Reclamation is authorized to enter into contracts for state and local law enforcement of federal lands. Reclamation has increased the level of surveillance and patrols of the dam since the terrorist attacks on September 11, 2001. The Contractor, through the Lewis and Clark County Sheriff's Department, has the responsibility for enforcement of state and local laws within Lewis & Clark County. [REDACTED] This contract provides for the Contractor to perform security surveillance and law enforcement at Canyon Ferry Dam and surrounding areas 365 days a year. This contract also provides for the Contractor to provide an additional patrol at Canyon Ferry Dam and surrounding areas during periods of heightened security. Canyon Ferry Reservoir is located in two counties; Broadwater and Lewis & Clark. [REDACTED]

**5a- Discussion in support of the above authority**

Reclamation and the Lewis & Clark County Sheriff's Department (Sheriff) have successfully worked cooperatively over the past 9 years to provide law enforcement, support, and emergency response at Canyon Ferry Dam, Powerplant, and surrounding areas. The Sheriff has primary jurisdiction in Lewis & Clark County, is the primary source for law enforcement, and is empowered by the State of Montana with full arrest authority in Lewis & Clark County. [REDACTED]

Reclamation's security program requirements mandated armed law enforcement personnel ready to respond to any intrusion alarm, terrorist or domestic threat, or other criminal activity on a 24/7 basis. The Sheriff is the only law enforcement agency that is prepared to meet this requirement without any undue delays or increased costs. Canyon Ferry Dam and Powerplant [REDACTED]. The Sheriff is the only law enforcement agency able to immediately comply with and respond to Reclamation's Threat Condition Protective Measure [REDACTED].

The Sheriff is unique by definition and the only source due to the jurisdictional responsibilities in Montana.


