

## JUSTIFICATION FOR OTHER THAN FULL AND OPEN COMPETITION

**Project Name: Security Cameras for Hoover Dam**

In accordance with FAR 6.302, the proposed contractual action is pursuant to the statutory authority of 41 U.S.C. 253(c)( 5 )

1. **Agency and Contracting Activity.** Bureau of Reclamation, Hoover Dam requires security camera supply and delivery. The supply will be purchased by the Acquisition and Assistance Management Office.
2. **Nature/Description of Action.** A FFP contract is anticipated to be awarded with a delivery date of 60 calendar days from award of contract.
3. **Description of Supplies/Services.** The purpose of this action is for the purchase of security cameras for Hoover. Some of the Cameras are for Parker and Davis Dams. It is anticipated that upon delivery of the cameras, they will be installed by the appropriate Reclamation personnel at the referenced Dams.

5. **Demonstration of Contractor's Unique Qualifications.** Multiple 8(a) contractors are able to supply and deliver security cameras and the 8(a) program is authorized by statute.
6. **Description of efforts made to maximize competition.** Two 8(a) firms were contacted, 3(t) Federal Solutions and Fortis. 3(t) did not have the capability to provide the required security cameras.

7. **Determination of Fair and Reasonable Cost.** The cost is determined to be fair and reasonable based on market research prices. Fortis price of \$241,660.57 is lower than the market research price of \$248,190.61 obtained from Flir Systems Inc.
8. **Description of Market Research Conducted.** Multiple firms were contacted in order for Hoover to develop the statement of work and determine the Government minimum acceptability requirements. APL and Flir Systems Inc. were contacted for market research.
9. **Listing of Interested Sources.** Other firms were contacted. APL and FLIR Systems Inc.
