Encouraging Reclamation to participate or contribute to Navajo Nation's programmatic approach for water infrastructure improvements rather than going off and doing their own separate project (that often doesn't fit in with the Nation's strategy or need). The approach is already in place and proven (ie. Leupp to Dilkon Pipeline, and Sweetwater Pipeline)

- Western Navajo Pipeline Phase I
  - o Build up groundwater supplies in Bodaway Gap and Tuba City; and surface water source at LeChee.
  - o Strengthen transmission capacity/reliability.
  - o Take Care of Lake Powell Intake and Treatment Issues
  - o Investigate connection to Coppermine
- Western Navajo Pipeline Phase II
  - o "Connect the dots" (construct connecting pipes between LeChee/Bodaway/Tuba City) as needed and as funding becomes available.
  - o Enlarge transmission/conveyance capacity
- Antelope Canyon
  - o Provide distribution facilities to serve the Antelope Canyon Road Corridor Commercial Development.
