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Frequently Asked Questions

Will the Conconully Lake RV Campground be open for the 2017 camping season?

Reclamation regrets that no opening date will be announced until water supply repairs are complete. The facility requires an overhaul of the well head and related plumbing. When water supply work is finished, campers may enjoy the 11 renovated campsites that meet ADA standards for accessibility and include a fully accessible campsite. Also added were and new sidewalks, fencing, information bulletin board and kiosk.

When can reservations be made and how do we do that?

We will announce campsite availability once improvements to the RV campground are finalized. We are exploring a temporary management arrangement with the Washington State Parks and Recreation Commission; however, no agreement has been made.

What updates have been made?

Reclamation made significant improvements to the RV campground:

- Built new restroom and shower facility
- Upgraded electrical system from 30 to 50 amps service
- Replaced sewer components
- Constructed one fully handicap accessible campsite. The ten remaining campsites all meet ADA accessibility standards
- Added 11 new fire rings
- Refurbished picnic tables for each campsite
- Installed a new paved walk-way and fence
- Added information kiosk and pay box

Will there be opportunity for private entities to manage the campground? Not at this time. Once the RV Campground is re-opened, Reclamation will begin a review of long-term management solutions for the Conconully Lake Recreation Area.

What will become of the cabins and boat docks? What are the plans for them? All appropriate environmental compliance will be completed prior to any long-term management decisions being made. There will be opportunities for public input during this process.
