This revision, consisting of a title page, this sheet showing official actions taken with respect to the plot, and the following General Map sheets outlining the farm unit boundaries, together with 3 supplemental sheets showing detailed drawings and descriptions of each farm unit, comprises the Sixth revision of the farm unit plot of Irrigation Block I of the Columbia Basin Project, dated April 21, 1948 and filed for record in the County Auditor's office of Franklin County, Washington, on April 30, 1948, Auditor's file No 115828. Previous revisions were made on October 26, 1950, April 8, 1953, August 11, 1955, August 18, 1958 and November 28, 1958.

The revisions in the farm unit plot, Irrigation Block No. 1, consist of:

In considering these revisions, investigations and studies were made of the lands in the block and the project as a whole with the object of determining the area, shape and boundaries of the various farm units in this block, having in mind the requirements of the Columbia Basin Project Act (57 Stat. 14) and of Chapter 275, Laws of Washington, 1943, as amended, and of the policies established thereunder by the Secretary of the Interior. Based on these studies and investigations and all relevant data brought forward since the filing of the farm unit plot, I find that the units as herein revised are of sufficient acreage for the support of an over-sized family at a suitable living level and have appropriate shapes and boundaries, having in mind the character of the soil, topography, location with respect to the irrigation system, and all other factors that are relevant to the determination of the area and boundaries of the farm units. Accordingly, actions pursuant to the authority delegated to the Commissioner of Reclamation by the Secretary of the Interior, as shown by Departmental Order 2765, dated July 30, 1954, and redelegated to me by the Commissioner of Reclamation by Commissioner's Order 34, dated October 6, 1954, and Commissioner's Order 34, Amendment 1, dated October 29, 1954, all as recorded in the Auditor's office of Franklin County, Washington, in Volume 87 of Columbia Basin Documents at page 44, and pursuant to the provisions of the Columbia Basin Project Act as amended, and Chapter 275, Laws of Washington, 1943, as amended, and the repayment contract of October 9, 1945, as amended, between the United States of America and the South Columbia Basin Irrigation District, I hereby revise the farm unit plot of Irrigation Block I, dated April 21, 1948, by (1) Replacing the General Map sheets of that plot with the General Map sheets of this plot and (2) Replacing supplemental sheet 5 of the plot revision recorded August 11, 1955 and supplemental sheet 4 of the plot revision recorded August 18, 1958 and supplemental sheet 1 of the plot revision recorded November 28, 1958 as revised, with sheets 1 through 3 respectively, of this plot.

CERTIFICATE

I hereby certify that this revised plot of Irrigation Block I, Columbia Basin Project, Washington, is based upon an actual survey and subdivision of Sections 1 and 12, Township 9 North, Range 28 East, Willamette Meridian; Sections 5 and 6, Township 9 North, Range 29 East, Willamette Meridian; Sections 1, 12, 13, 24, 25 and 36 of Township 10 North, Range 28 East, Willamette Meridian; and Sections 18, 19, 20, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32 and 33, Township 10 North, Range 29 East, Willamette Meridian; that the distances and angles are shown thereon correctly; that the monuments have been set and farm unit corners staked on the ground.

The General Map sheets show in tabular form the irrigable area in each farm unit by classes of land and the portions within each farm unit required for rights-of-way or designated as Class 5 (temporarily unproductive), Class 6 (non-irrigable), or "high". The land classes indicated in the tabulation on the maps were designated and established on November 13, 1958 by the Regional Director, Region I, Bureau of Reclamation, for and on behalf of the Secretary of the Interior. Lands in Class 5 are regarded as being temporarily unproductive because of remote conditions. Lands in Class 6 are regarded as non-irrigable. Lands designated as "high" are regarded as being at an elevation beyond the economical reach of the distribution system being provided for the Irrigation block. The State of Washington and appropriate counties have furnished, upon the solicitation of the United States, information showing changes in alignment and rights-of-way for public highways and roads under their jurisdiction. To the extent that it has been practicable so to do, these data have been correctly placed and shown on this revised plot. In the last year of the development period for the block an announcement to the Irrigation District will be issued by the Secretary of the Interior establishing and fixing the irrigable areas and land classes of each farm unit in the block for purposes of water service charges and project construction repayment as provided for in the repayment contract of October 9, 1945, as amended between the United States of America and the South Columbia Basin Irrigation District, recorded in Franklin County, Washington, in Volume 1 of Columbia Basin Documents, page 1 to 21 inclusive.
