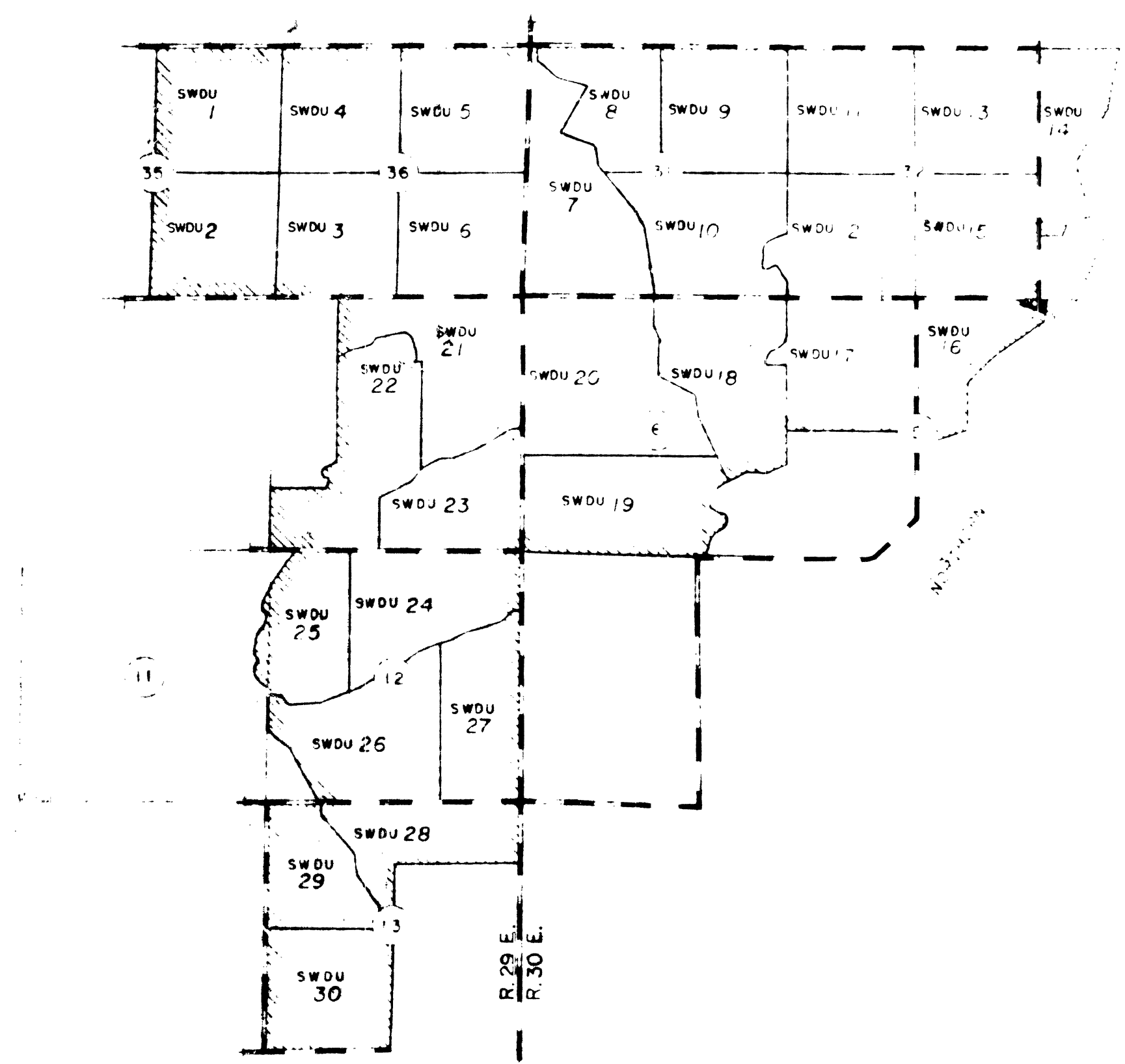
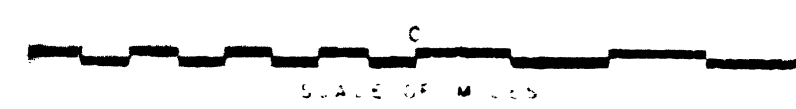


COLUMBIA BASIN PROJECT- IRRIGATION BLOCK 161

FINAL IRRIGABLE AREA SURVEY

This acreage tabulation is based on the ten-year irrigable area survey, which becomes effective at the beginning of the first year of the construction repayment period for the block (January 1, 1977).

- 1/-All units in the block are special water delivery units. A special water delivery unit is a unit of land normally served by a single turnout in which all or a portion of the unit is classified for sprinkler irrigation only or for any method other than the method of irrigation normally used in a unit.
- 2/-Lands in Class 6 are regarded as nonirrigable.
- 3/-High lands were not delineated in the block. Arable lands located at a higher elevation than the turnout or measuring device are included in the irrigable area because of the designation of all units as special water delivery units.
- 4/-Includes land having potential seepage problems for which construction of drainage works is not economically feasible, as evidenced by recorded agreement.

The Final Irrigable Areas and Land Repayment classes of each Unit in Irrigation Block 161, as established, and fixed by my certificate of December 29, 1976 are shown on the following 8 sheets of this Irrigable Area Map.
